


Proposed Cruising Itinerary: Newport and Martha's Vineyard

Day One

- Arrive any time after 10 AM aboard Lady Catherine docked in the quaint colonial village of Wickford, Rhode Island

- Settle into your stateroom(s) then depart for Newport, a pleasant one hour cruise down Narragansett Bay. Lunch will be served on the aft deck overlooking the busy historic harbor. Take the launch to shore to spend the afternoon touring the famous Newport mansions or stroll thru the shops and galleries.

Day Two

- Sleep in or enjoy the view over breakfast on the aft deck as we depart Newport Harbor in the morning on our approx 5 hour cruise to the Vineyard.
- Cruise past Hammersmith Farm, Jackie Kennedy's childhood summer home and the many other waterfront mansions along the south coast of Rhode Island.
- Lunch will be served on the aft deck as we cruise past the Island of Cuttyhunk & the Elizabeth Islands, most privately owned by the Forbes family. View the beautiful cliffs of Gay Head as we enter Vineyard Sound.
- Arrive Edgartown Harbor mid afternoon. Explore the charming village in the afternoon. Then watch the tourists turn green with envy as you return to your private classic yacht for cocktails and hors d'oeuvres.
- Dinner ashore, your choice of casual or elegant dining.



Day Three

- Leisurely breakfast on Lady Catherine, served at your convenience. Spend the day at the beach or rent a bike to visit the neighboring village of Oak Bluffs. Want to see it all? Lady Catherine's crew can arrange for you to tour the island by bus, moped or private car. Stop to explore any of the six quaint villages on the island, each with unique character. Lunch or dinner aboard the yacht, depending on your plans for the day.

Day Four Need to return home? We'll depart early morning for the approx 6 hour cruise back to Wickford. Or if you want more time on the Vineyard spend the day exploring Oak Bluffs then catch the Fast Ferry back to Wickford in the afternoon.
